Video training resource

This resource focuses on important principles for best practice and the development of an appropriate working relationship for a disability support worker (DSW) when providing support for personal care for people with a disability.

It has primarily been developed to assist support workers who may have difficulty due to different cultural backgrounds, English language or literacy difficulties by providing visual demonstrations with explanatory voiceover for a *selection* of personal support procedures with emphasis on the working relationship with the client during the procedures.

The vignettes have NOT been designed as a stand-alone resource for learners. They should be used, together with the accompanying documents, for facilitated group reflection on, and discussion about, practices demonstrated in the scenarios.

The five video vignettes last approximately 30 minutes in total and the student worksheets test and reinforce the knowledge and skills covered in the vignettes.
