### DESCRIPTION

This is a WELL-funded (Workplace English Language & Literacy) resource for learning and development of staff involved with children at risk.

The resource supports the CHCPROT531A: *Interview children for investigation of child protection concerns* unit of competency of the CHC08 Community Services Training Package.

The resource is to support the development of skills of new case workers with limited experience in interviewing and communicating with children. It does NOT focus on specialist forensic child interviewing.
